Sub: Grant of Conditional Permission to Govt. Tibbia College and Hospital, BudhMurti, KadamKuan, Patna-800003, Bihar (Inst. ID. UNI0277) with intake capacity of 25 seats (31 seats including EWS) [instead of 100 seats (125 seats including EWS)] in UG (BUMS) course and 18 seats (22 seats including EWS) [instead of 25 seats (31 seats including EWS)] in 05 PG courses in the subject namely (i) IlmuAdvia- 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) (ii) Mahiyatul Amraz - 02 seats [instead of 05 seats (06 seats including EWS)] (iii) Tahafuzzi-wa-samaji Tib-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) [instead of 05 seats (06 seats including EWS)] (iv) Moalajat-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) [instead of 05 seats (06 seats including EWS)] and (v) Kulliyat -05 seats (06 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under.

Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Govt. Tibbia College and Hospital, BudhMurti, KadamKuan, Patna-800003, Bihar (Inst. ID. UNI0277)**, inspection of your College was conducted on **12.02.2024 & 13.02.2024 on Hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process **the Conditional Permission with intake capacity of 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BUMS) course and 25 seats (31 seats including EWS) in 05 PG courses in the subject namely (i) IlmuAdvia- 05 seats (07 seats including EWS) (ii) Mahiyatul Amraz - 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) (iii) Tahafuzzi-wa-samaji Tib-05 seats (06 seats including EWS) (iv) Moalajat-05 seats (06 seats including EWS) and (v) Kulliyat -05 seats (06 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2024-25, under Section 28 of NCISM ACT 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.**
2. Further, in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Unani Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for post-graduate Unani Colleges and

attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016" and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. On examining the case in light of above notified and approved criteria and on perusal of the visitation report, it was observed that the college was not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria due to following shortcomings: -

1) **Teaching Pharmacy – Quality testing lab is not available.**

2) **Teaching staffs: -**

a) Availability of total teaching staff for issuance of conditional permission for intake capacity with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) Course is Available/Required $\times 100\% = 25/45 \times 100\% = 42.22\%$ (Excluding Excess), which is not fulfilling the criteria as per Sub Regulation (1) (a) of Regulation 8 and Schedule-V of MSR 2016.

3. In view of above, the assessment report was placed in the **84th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on **21.03.2024**. On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed therein as mentioned above the college was given an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of **even no.** dated **14.06.2024** to appear on **21.06.2024** before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to **why not the Conditional permission to your college with Govt. Tibbia College and Hospital, BudhMurti, KadamKuan, Patna-800003, Bihar (Inst. ID. UNI0277) with intake capacity of 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BUMS) course and 25 seats (31 seats including EWS) in 05 PG courses in the subject namely (i) IlmuAdvia- 5 seats (07 seats including EWS) (ii) Mahiyatul Amraz – 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) (iii) Tahafuzzi-wa-samaji Tib-05 seats (6 seats including EWS) (iv) Moalajat-05 seats (06 seats including EWS) and (v) Kulliyat -05 seats (06 seats including EWS) under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 be denied for the Academic Year 2024-25.**
4. The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted the submissions **vide ref no. Nil dated 18.06.2024** against the deficiencies conveyed to them. Whereas, the college through its representatives, **Dr. Mohd Mahfoozur Rahman (Principal), Dr. Jamal Akhtar (Associate Professor) and Dr. Mohd Anas (Associate Professor)**, appeared before the Hearing Committee on **21.06.2024** and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college. The shortcomings communicated to the college, submission made by the representatives of the Unani college and observations made by the Hearing Committee are as under:-

In respect to the number of deliveries, college has informed that, they are awaiting for the approval of Janani Yojana Scheme in their institute which is under process.

5. Animal House: -

With regard to the Animal house college has submitted MoU with Bihar Animal Science University Patna dated 28.02.2023 and Valid for 5 years.

Recommendation: - Can be considered.

5. Thereafter, the observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Unani Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Unani Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations there under, and once again the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the **94th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 25.06.2024.**
6. In view of the observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report has been carefully examined in terms of concerned Regulation and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and Board Decided that the **college is not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for grant of conditional permission with intake capacity of 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BUMS) course and 25 seats (31 seats including EWS) in 05 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Iilmul Advia- 05 seats (07 seats including EWS) (ii) Iilmul Amraz - 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) (iii) Tahafuzzi-wa-samaji Tib-05 seats (06 seats including EWS) (iv) Moalajat-05 seats (06 seats including EWS) and (v) Kulliyat -05 seats (06 seats including EWS). However, Board decided to issue conditional permission as per the approved Seat Reduction Policy in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 for failing to maintain the minimum essential standards for the Academic year 2024-25.**

For UG course: -

- a) **"For deficiency of every one teacher, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 05% of total intake capacity."**

Accordingly, as per Schedule-V Note (iii) of Unani MSR 2016 the deficiency of teacher for up to sixty intake capacity shall not exceed more than ten percent of total requirement. As per the Hearing Committee observation and approval of Minutes in the 94th Board meeting of MARBISM, college is having only 25 total eligible Teaching faculties.

There is deficiency of 15 teachers for issuance of conditional permission for academic session 2024-25 as per Schedule-V Note (iii) of Unani MSR 2016. Therefore, in accordance of Reduction policy 2024-25, for deficiency of every one teacher, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 05% of total intake capacity.

Accordingly, in accordance of Seat Reduction policy 2024-2025 seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 75 seats of total intake capacity.

For PG course: -

- a) **"In case of non-availability of Professor in the Post graduate department or specialty permission shall be granted as per the teacher student ratio by reducing the intake strength in the concerned department".**

As per sub regulation 1 and 2 of regulation 16 of (PG Unani Education) Regulation 2016, The teacher-student ratio shall be such that the number of post-graduate teachers to the number of post-graduate students admitted per year is maintained as 1:3 in case of Professor and 1:2 in case of Reader or Associate Professor and as per sub regulation 2 of regulation 16 of (PG Unani Education) Regulation 2016 The teacher student ratio shall be 1:1 in case of Lecturer or Assistant Professor having minimum of five years teaching experience.

- i. **In the department of Tahaffuziwa-Samaji, college is having 04 eligible faculty [01 Associate Professor and 03 Assistant Professor (one with more than 05 years of teaching experience)] and there is shortcoming of 01 Professor and accordingly as per the available faculty, college is fulfilling the teacher student ratio as per the submitted seats in Part-1 and eligible for issuance of permission with 03 seats (04 seats including EWS) instead of 05 seats (06 seats including EWS).**
- ii. **In the department of Mahiyatul Amraz, college is having 02 eligible faculty [02 Assistant Professor with more than 05 years of teaching experience] and there is shortcoming of 01 Professor and accordingly as per the available faculty, college is fulfilling the teacher student ratio as per the submitted seats in Part-1 and eligible for issuance of permission with 02 seats instead of 05 seats (06 seats including EWS).**
- iii. **In the department of Moalejat, college is having 03 eligible faculty [03 Assistant Professor with more than 05 years of teaching experience] and there is shortcoming of 01 Professor and accordingly as per the available faculty, college is fulfilling the teacher student ratio as per the submitted seats in Part-1 and eligible for issuance of permission with 03 seats (04 seats including EWS) instead of 05 seats (06 seats including EWS).**

Accordingly, after applying the seat reduction policy 2024-25 under section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020, college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of **intake capacity of 25 seats (31 seats including EWS) [instead of 100 seats (125 seats including EWS)] in UG (BUMS) course and 18 seats (22 seats including EWS) [instead of 25 seats (31 seats including EWS)] in 05 PG courses in the subject namely (i) IlmuAdvia- 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) (ii) Mahiyatul Amraz - 02 seats [instead of 05 seats (06 seats including EWS)] (iii) Tahafuzzi-wa-samaji Tib-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) [instead of 05 seats (06 seats including EWS)] (iv) Moalajat-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) [instead of 05 seats (06 seats including EWS)] and (v) Kulliyat -05 seats (06 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2024-25**

7. Therefore, in view of shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned as above and after applying Seat reduction Policy 2024-25, **Conditional Permission is being issued to Govt. Tibbia College and Hospital, Budh Murti, Kadam Kuan, Patna-800003, Bihar (Inst. ID. UNI0277) with intake capacity of 25 seats (31 seats including EWS) [instead of 100 seats (125 seats including EWS)] in UG (BUMS) course and 18 seats (22 seats including EWS) [instead of 25 seats (31 seats including EWS)] in 05 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Ilmu Advia- 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) (ii) Mahiyatul Amraz - 02 seats [instead of 05 seats (06 seats including EWS)] (iii) Tahafuzzi-wa-samaji Tib-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) [instead of 05 seats (06 seats including EWS)] (iv) Moalajat-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) [instead of 05 seats (06 seats including EWS)] and (v) Kulliyat -05 seats (06 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-regarding.**

- (i) It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 25 seats (31 seats including EWS) instead of 100 seats (125 seats including EWS)] and 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity in 18 seats (22 seats including EWS) [instead of 25 seats (31 seats including EWS) in 05 PG courses** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as

the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

8. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
9. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
10. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
11. The **following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2024 and send a compliance report to be considered for the grant of permission for the academic session 2025-2026:**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Unani colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2023.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani Education) Regulations-2022.
 - iv) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Unani Education) Regulations, 2016.
 - v) The shortcoming mentioned in Para no. 4.
12. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.
